

In this case the hinge-side hinge-bars need to be raised - and the latch-side hinge-bars might need to be lowered. Depending on the sevarity of the slope, the hinge-side hinge-bars need to be raised father than the post will allow (without running into the header. We have built special hinge-bars in this situation. Contact us if you run into this problem.

Sometimes it is easier to simply reverse the door-swing so the hinge is higher than the latch.



Hinge-side is higher than the latch-side.

If there is enough room to lift the latch -

The quickest solution is to raise the latch-side hinge-bar.

This can be done by drilling new holes on the post for the latch-side hinge-bar. The top of the hinge-bar might have to be cut off to allow the hinge-bar to fit below the header.
